Prayer Points

Our Church

The Spirit of Christmas — It is the season of Advent, leading up to Christmas. Our sermon series on Isaiah deals with the themes of longing and promise, recovering the depths of human need and God's grace that meet in the true meaning of Christmas.

As we pray over the political turmoil, the cultural ills, and the personal brokenness of our time, we find promise and hope in God's word, in God's gift of Immanuel, the gift of the Holy Spirit, and the promise of Christ's return. Let us pray for a deeper appreciation and celebration of Christmas.

SLA Meeting (13 Dec) — Do continue to pray for God's favour to be on the meeting relating to our land lease renewal, to take place between Pastor Alby and team, and officials from the Singapore Land Authority (SLA). Pray that God will enable us to renew the lease, and to continue our witness and ministry here in Bishan.

Friendship Meal (17–21 Dec) — Thank God for this opportunity to share the spirit and message of Christmas. Pray for more to volunteer to serve during this outreach week.

Our World

St Thomas Church — Praise God that they recently celebrated the 20th Anniversary of their mission to the unreached parts of their nation, and had a mission consultation to broaden their vision for ministry.

Keep praying for the team, who are there to share about discipleship and early childhood education. Pray that they may depend on the Lord and the leading of the Holy Spirit in all things, that they may be responsive to Him, to serve well as a team, and together with the local leaders.

Pray for the participants to learn much: that the ministry trainees will grow in their understanding of prayer and personal mission statement, and that the early childhood teachers will gain good insights in pedagogy and classroom setup. Pray for God's protection over all involved.

Yemen — Pray for real progress toward peace through talks that have been held in Sweden between the warring parties. The country is under imminent threat of famine due to the 4-year civil war, also seen as a proxy war between Saudi Arabia and Iran.

Christmas: Gift-Exchange or Gift-Giving?

I was in a Christmas organizing meeting many years ago when the idea of getting the worshippers to bring a gift for exchange was discussed. There were concerns that people may be obliged and fears that some will “take and not bring.” Then there were concerns that some will be shortchanged if the value of the gift they received is lesser than the gift they prepared. Of course there were also fears that some will prepare less than ideal gifts. It was finally agreed that each person will be “encouraged” to bring a gift of around five dollars.

It seemed like a neat solution. But that discussion caused me a sleepless night. I felt something fundamental was missing in that meeting. We were so caught up with the physical value of the gifts that we missed the spiritual value. We were side-tracked by the perceived spirit of the people coming for the Christmas service that we missed out on the spirit of Christmas. We were *planning for Christmas* but missed out on the *spirit of Christmas*. Christmas is never about gift-exchange; it is about gift-giving.

“For God so loved the world, that he **gave** his only Son,
that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.”

(John 3:16, emphasis added)

How will your Christmas be this year? If you do not yet have plans, I invite you to pray about being a part of the spirit of Christmas:

1. **December 8 Christmas Outreach.** Join in the follow-up of the friends who came.
2. **December 17–21 Friendship Meals at The Living Room.** Join as servers and befrienders in this community outreach.
3. **December 25 Christmas Service.** Christmas services are known to rekindle the faith of those who have “back-slided.” If you know of someone, bring the person along and commit to following-up with that person.
4. **December 30 Christmas Outreach Party for Foreign Domestic Helpers.** Bring your helper, be a befriender, or even prepare gifts for them.
