Camp Courtesies & **Safety**

1. Participate in all activities. We value your presence.
 - Be punctual.
 - Dress appropriately for the occasion.
2. Appreciate those serving you.
 - Practise 'gracitude' at all times. Be patient during check-in.
 - Respect the private time of camp officials and doctors.
(Do not call after midnight unless there's an emergency)

Camp Courtesies & Safety

3. **Be vigilant.** Do not let others worry about you.

- Inform either the camp commandant, officials or group leader of any irregularities; or if you are leaving camp.
- Young children should be accompanied by an adult when using the swimming pool.
- Take care of your own passport, room keys and valuables.
- Return to your room before midnight.
- Unmarried singles of opposite sex (unless you are siblings) are not to be in room alone at any time.

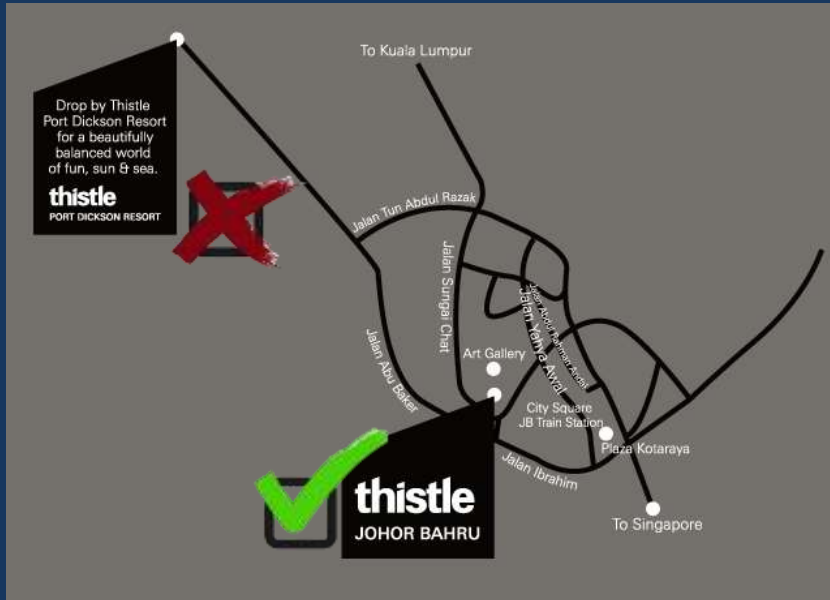
4. Be responsible. Leave a good impression.

- Take good care of hotel property.
- Show consideration to other hotel guests.
(e.g. keep noise level down especially after 10 pm)
- Be a good testimony to the hotel staff who serve us.
- No consumption of alcohol in rooms.
- Be prompt to settle your account (personal expenses) with the hotel before check out.

5. Be friendly. Smile and make new acquaintances.

- Help us remember your name by wearing your name tag.
- Be thoughtful, courteous and considerate to one another (especially at mealtimes).

For drivers, before you start ...

- Bring passport(s) & driving license
- Have Singapore cash card (> SGD10) and Malaysia Touch n Go (TnG) card (> RM20)
- Petrol tank $>\frac{3}{4}$ full
- PRAY

For drivers, getting there ...

- Go to Woodlands Causeway (not Tuas/2nd link)
 - Pay cash card SGP 3.80
- Proceed to JB Immigration/checkpoint
 - (optional) Top up TnG card – go lane 10.
 - Pay TnG card RM 9.70
 - No white card required

For drivers, getting there ...

- Exiting JB Immigration
 - Follow green floor, keep right.
