## **Prayer Points**

#### **Our Church**

Church shelter (20 Apr) – Many shelter seekers are displaced due to safe-distancing measures causing reduced housing availability. Session has approved and responded to MSF's appealed for churches to provide temporary housing for displaced people during Circuit Breaker. From 20 April to 4 May, Zion Bishan will open five rooms on the ground floor as temporary housing for five individuals. The Living Room café will be providing meals for them.

#### **ZB COVID-19 Mission Relief Fund (p.6)**

– In these times of manifold needs everywhere, do pray that we, and for all churches, to rise up, "stand in the gap" (Ez 22:30-31) and provide relief for the saints. The majority of us may have our lifestyles disrupted in this season. But for many others, including church members, their livelihoods are in jeopardy. Session has approved the commencement of the Zion Bishan COVID-19 Mission Relief Fund and we invite you to prayerfully consider partnering with us in this endeavour.

## **Our People**

Domestic Helpers – Lev 19:34 exhorts us to "love the alien [in our midst] as yourself." Pray for domestic helpers who take care of our families, while they are apart from theirs. Pray also for employers and families to understand their blessed position to be faithful stewards of the lives that God has entrusted to them. May they consider how to show God's love to their helpers and share the gospel of Jesus Christ with them.

#### **Our World**

West Bengal, India — In the midst of India's lockdown, we thank God for a ministry partner who visited families and identified, and addressed food concerns in the neighbourhood.

In collaboration with the community, the mission partner managed to provide rice and dhal for the needy. Praise God for this initiative.

Pray for their protection from the virus even as they use protective gear and practice safe distancing. May they persevere in reaching out to the community even as the lockdown extends beyond the intended deadline.

### **Ministry Partner in Central Philippines**

— Update on Primen, who has heart problems. Thank God a cardiologist is able to examine him. Do pray that necessary medical facilities will be available for his examination.

Pray also for Primen who stays alone in the Cebu Mission Centre, for healing and financial provision for the medical examination and follow-up treatment.

## Zion Bishan COVID-19 Mission Relief Fund

Dear Zion Bishan Members,

We are in troubled times! Not only is our way of life affected, but for many, their means of life are also threatened. These include our church members, the surrounding community, and our mission partners who co-labour with us to proclaim the Gospel. Hence, the Session has set up a designated Zion Bishan COVID-19 Mission Relief Fund. This Fund serves three purposes.

Firstly, in-reach to our members. If you are affected by the current situation and need help, please reach out to your AG leader, Cluster leader, any pastors or ministry staff. Even if you are not affected financially, we have a group of Peer Support Group volunteers who stand ready to support you spiritually and emotionally. We want to be of help!

Secondly, outreach to our community. There are many in our community who are elderly and limited in mobility like some in the Golden Jasmine retirement block near us. We wish to be their neighbour in their times of need (Luke 10:25-37). We are also in touch with the community leaders and have identified a few such seniors who need help with groceries and meals.

Thirdly, outreach to our mission partners. Many of our mission partners are facing dire needs not only concerning their own livelihood but also the ministry as well. In peace times, we support them in propagating the Gospel in Word. In such trying times, we want also to be supporting them in proclaiming the Gospel in works—Love your neighbour as yourself.

Hence, we would also like to appeal to those of you whom God has blessed much with to prayerfully consider this:

- 1. Give towards this Fund for the relief of the saints.
- 2. There is a nation-wide movement from those who may not need the latest \$600 government subsidy to give towards a worthy cause. Do consider giving your \$600 subsidy to one of these. If you wish, you may also give to our ZB COVID-19 Mission Relief Fund.

As in the parable of the talents (Matthew 25:14-30), we are reminded that we are only stewards of what God had entrusted to us. Let us then strive, to always *proclaim the Word*, and where needed, to *proclaim in works* our faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.
