## **Our Church**

The Next Lap – Each week, look out for one part of our vision moving forward. This was presented last week:

**Our Commitment** – To make it possible for *all to come for corporate worship weekly*.

We started this once a month for each cluster when services were capped at 50 pax. We increased it to twice a month (for 100 pax services) on a rotational basis. Looking ahead, when we go up to 200 pax (the capacity of our main sanctuary with safe-distancing and 50pax zoning), we can have all members returning weekly.

After which, we will no longer rotate the clusters, which has been making it difficult for our Sunday-based ministries to operate and has disrupted many family routines.

In-Person Services – Thank God for the government approval to conduct inperson services for up to 200 worshippers. Thank God for our Taskforce, who have been hard at work, making the necessary arrangements quickly for Christmas and Watchnight services. We will start 200pax in-person Sunday Services in a few weeks. Details will follow soon.

Friendship Meal (21-23 Dec) – Thank God for the smooth running of 3 days of Friendship Meals at the Living Room this past week. Despite some wet weather, thank God we were able to host many visitors. Thank God for the ministry through our Living Room Café.

## **Our People**

New Year's Eve Family Devotion — Close the year together with this prayer in our New Year's Eve devotions (p.8), "We want to testify to Your goodness in our lives; we want to feed on Your Word; and we want to renew our commitment to walk with You and live for You."

#### **Our World**

Phase 3 – Thank God that Singapore is moving to Phase 3 on 28 Dec. Let us not take for granted the safety and privilege we have, but use the freedom and safety we have to build one another up in Christ. With the opportunity to gather in larger groups of 8, pray that we will use these opportunities to share God's love with those in need, physically, emotionally and spiritually.

North India – Our ministry partner has reported that 2020 has drawn all their ministries closer to God. Praise God that even through hardships experienced, it has brought about renewed dependence on the Lord. Also, praise God that they have been able to continue with Bible studies and Sunday pulpit ministries online. The congregation has been blessed through their study of 1 Peter. Pray that God will give all the ministry workers strength and wisdom as they continue to face the challenging situations in their villages because of the pandemic and its severe impact.

### An Intentional Church

Zion Bishan's leadership has recently been communicating the need for all of us to come back weekly for in-person physical services. This is a big topic to think through! I hope that what we've heard over the past few weeks at service has been helpful for everyone to see that coming back is not the end goal, but can be a big part of growing us as the Body of Christ (which IS the end goal). I say "can be", because routinely coming back for weekly services is not enough. We must be **intentional** about what we do when we come back.

Even a cursory look at Christian community in the New Testament churches will show that a healthy church must spend quality time together – and lots of it!<sup>1</sup>

So what does being **intentional** with our time together physically look like? A lot has been and can be said about what happens in services themselves, but let me suggest some practical ways we can really use our time together well:

#### 1. Short 5-10 minute conversations

Imagine if every single Sunday, we all took the time to come earlier and stayed behind for just a few minutes to catch up with one another. These precious minutes would add up to hours of meaningful relationships over a year. We can pray with and for each other, and for what we've heard in the sermon to impact our hearts.

#### 2. Longer, deeper conversations

What if we went further than that? If we arranged for an hour-long meal before with one another before or after service at the coffeeshops near church? More time spent with one another will allow us to get deeper into what's happening in each other's lives, and deeper into His Word than we could in brief conversations.

#### 3. Conversations with church leaders

Finally, we as church leaders have been really longing to see you and interact with you. How can we possibly love, lead and pray for you if we don't spend time with you? This is one of the big reasons why one Pastor and two Elders have been assigned to a single congregation each in the Next Lap Vision. Please come to us and say hello each Sunday — we'd love to hear how you are doing and to pray for you!

Imagine how much we as a church family would grow as one Body if we are **intentional** with such things when we come back for service each and every week?
