Acts 3:1-26

24 January 2021 Mr Quek Tze-Ming /Pastor Dev Menon

The Lame Beggar Healed (3.1-10)

Peter Explains Again! (3.11-26)

Reflection Questions:

- 1. What is the significance of the location of this event? What do you think the lame beggar expected from Peter and John?
- 2. In Acts 3:16 Peter says the beggar was healed in Jesus' name. In what way is this NOT a magical incantation? What more was involved and what does that mean?
- 3. How did Peter explain that all that had happened to Jesus was a part of God's plan (Acts 3:21-26)?
- 4. The "completely" healed man was a powerful testimony to the power of God and the truth of Peter's words. How have you seen the power of God demonstrated in your life and in the lives of others?

Pray for final preparations this week and for smooth transitions to ensure adherence to safety measures alongside the increased capacity. Thank God for their service and for looking into the myriad of details & activities happening each week such as CD and YD classes.

Mrs Serene Chang – is the new Zion Bishan Kindergarten (ZBK) principal who began her appointment at the start of this year. Pray for her as she leads the team of teachers with wisdom, strength and empowerment from the Holy Spirit. Pray for protection over our ZBK teachers and students, and their families, as they continue their school activities.

Our World

Indonesia – A powerful earthquake hit Sulawesi island on Friday (15 Jan) and more than 73 deaths have been reported. Our ministry partner is transporting aid for those in need by trucks. Pray for safety in their travels, dry weather and smooth distribution of their relief effort. Pray that through their work, aid recipients will feel God's love and hear the gospel.

Lebanon – Pray for the provision of essential medicines, ventilators and food for the Lebanese people. These are very scarce because of total lockdown conditions imposed till February. Pray for healing for our ministry partner and his family who were all diagnosed with COVID this week. Despite this, thank God that their organisation continues to feed 450 needy families.

Singapore – Pray for everyone to maintain vigilance to keep the spread of COVID in the community low. With our relative safety, pray for the church in Singapore to understand what God is doing in our country, and in the world, so that all of God's children will align our hearts and hands towards His mission to reach the world with His gospel.

Basic AG Leaders Equipping (BAGLE) Course

Leading an AG can be quite a perplexing role. Most people *sort of* know what an AG Leader does. Maybe most AG Leaders themselves have a *rough idea* of what's required of them. But somehow, what the AG Leader *actually* does can sometimes be quite different from all of the above! It's a little like that meme where "what my friends think I do" versus "what my parents think I do" versus "what I think I do" and "what I *really* do" are all completely different. I know this from personal experience as an AG Leader too!




This, of course, shouldn't be the case – helping our AG Leaders in Zion Bishan be both *clear and convicted* of their roles in God's church is what the Discipleship Team strives towards. Such clarity is really crucial if every member in Zion Bishan is to be actively engaged in our vision together – to #GetDeep in God's Word, #GetReal with one another and ultimately #GetLost for our Lord Jesus.

While there is already a regular structure in place for the past 4-5 years to equip our AG Leaders (i.e. the weekly Leaders Prep Bible handling training), leading an AG also comes with many other challenges.

What does my role as an AG Leader truly entail? How can we grow our members to Christlikeness and healthy service of the Body?

What should we do in situations of crisis and pastoral issues? Can I say anything to anyone if I'm on the verge of ministry burnout?

Those were some of the key questions our AG Leaders grappled with over the duration of the 6-week BAGLE course via Zoom. BAGLE, at its core, is really for every AG Leader (new or weathered) to return to the basics of discipleship – growing disciples who enjoy the beauty of Jesus, who, in turn disciple others for that same glorious goal. We spent the bulk of our time thinking through what the Bible depicts as a healthy ministry model – one that grows every believer to maturity in Jesus. At the same time, we also acknowledged that such life-giving ministry can be life-draining – so how do we shepherd God's flock in a manner and at a pace that is sustainable in the long run for every AG Leader?



Leaders' Reflections

Here are some reflections from the participants of our recent run from May to June:



Michael Bin (AG73): We need to see God rightly, by seeing ourselves rightly. Moving forward, I will endeavour to take less pride in the works of my hands and even some of my strengths (e.g. industriousness), but shall endeavour to be more humble when approaching others as well as God. In terms of preventing burnout and working towards sustainable ministry, I need to learn to be more open to saying "No",

and to be more open to my loved ones who provide me with alerts about signs of burn out/fatigue in my life. To learn to delegate more, and involve more AG members in organising/facilitating AG activities (e.g. socials, or even caring for other members of the AG).



Grace Wong (AG40): Discipleship is walking with someone in the faith and allowing them to find out more about Jesus. Being patient, not expecting everyone to understand every study that is taught and to let God teach them in His time and His way. In terms of self-care and rest, I hope to remember to take time for myself and to spend more

time alone with God. To allow the co-leaders to understand each other and support each other more in this ministry.



Elder Chuah Chin Yew (AG12): BAGLE was a good refresher in reminding me of Speaking the truth, Toiling with perseverance, Everyone being involved, and Praying in dependence on the Spirit (STEP) so that we're running AG meaningfully. In terms of burnout prevention, we need to recognize our need to rest and lead a balanced lifestyle.



June Quek (AG75): Go make disciples of all nations doesn't only mean conversion but to grow disciples in their spiritual maturity in Christ, knowing Him, loving Him, serving Him. Preaching to non-Christians is equally important as growing disciples, just that it's less obvious in terms of fruit in the short term with growing disciples. Just labour on... In terms of guarding against burnout and working towards sustainable ministry, I've got to be disciplined to

block out time to spend with God and His people. At least 2-3 days every 6 months.



Annette Wong (AG50): Good to remember that discipleship is based on the Word but also that reading the Bible together helps in the sharing of lives and asking of difficult questions. Will be more intentional about asking deeper personal questions relating to the text when doing one-to-one Bible reading, and avoid a 'touch-andgo' way of doing it (e.g. reading one book and moving on to another

person quickly). In terms of self-care and sustainable ministry, it was helpful to know the definitions of burnout and what it looks like when one is heading towards that. Practical steps - ensure I regularly talk to close Christian friends about walk with God, thoughts and feelings about ministry so that I can be encouraged and likewise encourage them in their ministry.



Catherine Dong (ZBCS, AG102): I learned more about biblical principles in serving and leading. It is God that we are serving and God will lead us along the way when we submit all our concerns to Him. In terms of rest, continual prayers on my own and with fellow Christian sisters are important. Practically, also continuing to engage in physical exercise and ensuring sufficient sleep.



Dns Jenny Zeng (ZBCS, AG102): I have benefited a lot from this course. It has covered many aspects in a comprehensive way from the discipleship based on Biblical truth to the practical ways of dealing with issues encountered at the individual level. It has deepened my understanding of being a follower of God; our faith is from Him and in Him. Jesus' words from the Great Commission encourage me a lot, as a disciple of God, I am not battling with bare hands, God is with me, and He has all authority in heaven and on

earth! This course has strengthened my faith that our faith is rooted in Him, from Him!
