Going Endemic – As we get used to a freely circulating virus, we want to make every effort to continue to meet safely. Safe Sound Sleeping Place (S3P) for Women – A sixth lady has joined S3P this week. Please continue to pray for the team caring for these ladies and thank God for His providence to use our church to shelter and help those in need.

Distribution – A dinner distribution will
be carried out this evening. Pray for
God's grace to be with Ps Ebi and our
Tamil Service representatives.

Our World

Foreign Missions Budget 2022 – Pray for the FMC (Foreign Missions Committee) as they meet to discuss our support for the work of the gospel in 9 areas worldwide, and also the individuals sent out. We are thankful that God has guided our church to work with like-minded partners and individuals to share His love and light to a dark world until it is filled with His glory. Pray for wisdom and diligence for the 9 committee members as they seek God and direct our church's work and resources appropriately.

India – Our partner gave an encouraging update on Bro B. He has adjusted well back into his ministry at his village after recovering from his amputation. He now stays very close to his late-wife's sister's family who have taken care of his daughter since his accident. Bro B also shared his testimony at his 2 churches: "When the bus hit me, I fell down, and S (his daughter) too. However, nothing happened to her. It took a while. I prayed to God to help me to make a phone call so that someone will come and take care of S. Then I made the phone call". Let us thank God for His mercies and continue to pray for Bro B and his ministry.

Lebanon – BBC described Lebanon as "A country plunged into darkness" (10 Sep). It is desperately short of fuel. Some are experiencing power cuts of 20 hours a day. Hospitals have cut back essential services and motorists queue for hours to fill their tanks. Our partner writes: "We need your prayers, encouragement and support now more than ever. The need is enormous, we need prayers for continuous unity and help". Pray for God's mercy for this country that is mired in economic, food and fuel crises. May Christ's light shine forth through believers during these dark times.

What is God Doing?

PS DEV MENON

Brothers & Sisters, do you know it's been 18 months since Covid-19 first impacted Zion Bishan? And over 6 months since we initiated 'The Next Lap' and formalised the four English congregations??

If you remember, The Next Lap vision came about because of 2 reasons: the short-term rationale was government-imposed restrictions; the other was to address longer-term challenges that we had struggled with over 5-7 years. Issues such as increasing pastoral cases, thin-discipleship, lack of faith-at-home, leaders burning out, etc. Essentially all the problems of a church growing too big.

Creating distinct congregations with dedicated shepherding teams would allow the benefits of small church - gaining advantages in communication, community, pastoral care and discipleship. Re-read the original write up: www.zionbishan.org.sg/2021/01/the-next-lap-moving-zion-bishan-forward

Now 6 months have passed, how are you feeling? More importantly, what have you seen God doing?

I recently took time to reflect on these questions with my fellow 5pm CST & AG leaders. It is paramount that we as a church don't just react to circumstances but keep God at the centre of all our decisions.

You know as we go through the book of Acts, I can't help but marvel as God directs His people. As the story progresses, it's like the apostles have no clue. They are desperately trying to discern the Spirit's movements as God breaks all the rules. He changes ethnicity & geography, language & culture, liturgy & methodology. The church post-Acts was unrecognizable to the original Jewish synagogue — except for the Scriptures. This whole experience must have been rather traumatic - to say the least!

So, if we serve the same God, with the same Spirit – who's to say He is not still doing radical things with His church – even here at Zion Bishan. As our God continues to disrupt us, we must try our best to discern what He is doing, humble ourselves, and follow His lead...

Indeed, God will be faithful. Let us keep moving forward.
