Acts 21-28 - The Final Section Overview

Paul's Mission: as King Jesus' chosen instrument to carry His Name and suffer for the sake of His Name before the Gentiles, the children of Israel and kings (9:15-16), and finally to Rome (19:21) to testify before Caesar (23:11; 27:24).

was finally restored after two days. The family is also packing to move to another place. Pray that they will have a smooth move to their new place.

Our World

India – Praise God for a fruitful trip by our partner in North India. Over 5 days, they travelled 1200km visiting 6 places. They work to uplift children in these various places. Thank God for safe travels and help when their vehicle got stuck in the mud in one village. We also want to rejoice with this same partner who welcomed their first grandson on 17 Sep. Pray for strength and good health for all the daycare centre (DCC) managers to carry out their responsibilities. Pray also that they will continue to have the zeal to serve the Lord with enthusiasm. Our partner's distribution of COVID relief has led to requests for help with children from 8 places in their area. Pray for wisdom and God's guidance to respond rightly to these requests.

Indonesia – Praise God for a retreat that was held in September for various field workers in this region. They were able to come together for a time of spiritual refreshment and training. Many face challenges and difficulties in the communities they serve. We thank God that they do not fear these challenges but face them with God's strength. Thank God for the faithful sowing of these workers in God's harvest field. Pray that these efforts will reap a harvest in God's time.

Fear-less or Fearless

The current pandemic has surfaced many fears. Fear of the virus, the vaccines, the unvaccinated, and even the vaccinated. Sometimes, the unvaccinated fear the vaccinated as they may be asymptomatic. It is understandable. With the number of cases being reported, more in the ICU and number of deaths climbing, it is hard not to fearful.

But the challenge is this. How do we protect ourselves, and others, while at the same time, not allowing fears to dominate our lives, divide friendships, and disrupt society? Perhaps it is good for us to learn from Asaph in Psalm 73 where he grappled with unpreventable and unexplainable suffering.

Verses 1-16, in my own words, says, "Why is this happening to me? I believe in God and I've tried to be a good Christian." But he does not end there. Asaph continues in verses 17-28, writing that while we may struggle with our present troubles, we must not stop at our present struggles.

Note how verse 1 reminds us to look back to see how God has brought us through past troubles and verse 17 exhorts us to look forward. Verses 17-22 tell us that God is ultimately in control even when things are out of control. Verses 23-26 gives us the assurance that we are never alone because God is with us. Most importantly, verses 27-28 remind us that God is, and His purpose is, ultimately sovereign. And that's the hope that we have.

Allow me to add something that I usually say in a funeral sermon – The end of life is not the end. There's still eternal life. We may suffer for, let's say, 70 years in an average life. But eternal life is *eternal* life! Even if we're to bear with suffering for 70 years, that compared to eternity is nothing.

In summary, Psalm 73 teaches us that when troubles hit us, look back and be reminded that God was not absent in our previous troubles.

When we see no way out, look forward and be assured. Even when we feel like it is the end of the world, it is not the end of the world. If we die, we are still going to a better place to be with God. That is why even if the pandemic worsens, we need not fear, nor try to fear less. We can be *fearless* in living out our faith in action!
