Preaching Team – Thank God for the faithful preachers who spend time studying and preparing God's Word to be taught to us. Pray for the team as they meet to discuss the upcoming Advent evangelistic series.

Our World

India – Pray for opportunities for our partner's workers to share the good

news in their villages in the Northeast. May the listeners receive the good news positively. Likewise, pray for good times of the reading and teaching of the Bible so that new believers can grow in their faith and maturity despite facing many challenges. Pray also that new workers can be raised for the new fields in this vast nation.

Lebanon – is again plunged into darkness as the country's two largest power stations shut down due to a fuel shortage (9 Oct). Pray for restoration of the economy and for wise political leadership to arise in these desperate times so that the suffering of the population can be eased. Pray for continued strength and hope for our partners here, who struggle daily to provide food and relief. Pray for some semblance of normal life to return for the refugees they serve and their church community.

Nepal – Praise God for the provision of a buffalo that will provide the much needed milk for children in a home, for the intellectually challenged, run by our partner. We also thank God for the purchase of a projector and sound system for their meetings and classroom lessons. This equipment has also helped us connect better with our partner virtually. Pray for God's blessings to be upon a wedding in their community between a pastor's son and a young lady who grew up in the children's home since she was 4.

On PSLE & Covid

The last month had been rather harrowing for me. It was PSLE season, and besides the normal stress-levels, there was the uncertainty of a new scoring system plus the insanity of dealing with an escalating pandemic.

Anxiety was palpable all round – with students, parents and teachers. No one knew what would happen, or if the children (who had studied so hard and for so long) would even be able to take their exams. A few hundred (!!) missed their papers –because of infection (which was generally mild), but many more because of quarantine orders and a backlogged healthcare system.

Throughout the entire period I was restless. Not so much of illness, but because of the worry that my social activities would cause the family to get QO/HRW, resulting in my son having to take a PCR, wait 24-48 hours for the result, miss some papers - and hence be utterly disappointed or worse still, resent his father.

After talking to him about the risks, Josiah assured me that he was fine with whatever happened - but this did not ease his daddy's anxieties. I wondered – what should I do? Should I cancel all my ministry, pull him out of school (like half his class), and hunker down for the next 2-3 weeks? Should I just carry on as per normal and hope for the best?

God spoke through His Word, through the book of Acts. As we followed the adventures of the apostle Paul, it was clear that he made decisions not being naïve to the risks (in fact in Acts 21 it's obvious that he knew more about the dangers than his peers), but knowing that if his actions were for Christ, then the Lord's sovereignty would be apparent.

As such, I made my resolution. I would continue my in-person activities, if and only if they were related to the kingdom; to minister to others in the name of Jesus. I would cut everything else. I knew that would not prevent me from getting infected or quarantined, but at least I did it for the Lord, and the Lord would use every situation for His glory.

This settled my anxieties somewhat... and thankfully nothing serious happened. My son took all his papers – even the one with Helen & Ivan.

Zion Bishan's Next Step towards a 'New Normal'

Dear Church Family, as our nation enters yet another stage of change in the pandemic, it is time for us to also move forward to best continue healthily growing together in Christ.

We had set aside September and October to allow us to observe the evolving situation and government guidelines – as well as to give time for our members to vaccinate themselves. We held alternate 50 persons "No Vaccination Requirement" and 250 persons "Vaccinated-Only" Services.

Over the last month or so, the following observations were made:

- Parents with children encountered disruptions to Children's Discipleship
 (CD) (and to some extent Youth Discipleship also) during "No Vaccination
 Requirement" Services because we are not able to run CD on these weeks.
- There were very few unvaccinated persons that chose to return for inperson service. Hence, the church's resources were largely underutilized.
- Many desired to return more regularly, and found the alternating services limiting, disruptive and confusing.

As God's good stewards, we also want to make best use of the church's resources such that we maximize our ministry to as many worshippers as possible, as often as possible. As such, we are going to deliberate on moving to 100% Vaccinated-Only Services weekly. In this way in-person CD (& YD) may continue regularly and more people can return weekly.

Our concern for our unvaccinated members remains – and we wish for all to be able to gather together to receive spiritual nourishment and fellowship necessary for Christian growth. Thus, the church is considering subsidizing the cost of the weekly Pre-Event Testing for our unvaccinated members to return for in person services. We will review the situation regularly and make further changes if necessary. As the author of Hebrews exhorts all believers in 10:24 & 25:

And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

It is our prayer and hope that this next step will result in Zion Bishan as a community of Christ not only survives but spiritually thrives in this pandemic. May we grow better through every challenge at encouraging one another to live for Jesus and the Day of His return!

Do keep Session in prayer as we meet this Tuesday to deliberate on this matter. Thank you for all your patience and support for the leaders as we prayerfully look to the Lord to help us navigate this difficult season.
