Our Church

COVID-19 Situation in Zion Bishan - To date, we have sent out notices informing members about two positive cases that were present at our church premises. We thank God that the first person has fully recovered and the second is recovering well. It seems that the virus is coming closer to our community with the second case being at a worship service while infectious. In fact, there have been other close calls as well. Two families had been placed on quarantine or stay home orders. Quite a few people were identified as close contacts, and others were issued health risk warnings. However, given our nation's position on an endemic COVID-19, this should come as no surprise as it is only a matter of time until we detect more cases among our worshippers coming for services.

So, as we encourage all who feel comfortable to do so to return for inperson worship and, in time, fellowship, let us continue to exercise caution and personal responsibility in protecting ourselves and our loved ones. As the Apostle Paul exhorts us in Phil 2:4 to be Christ-like, "let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others."

Our People

Children's Ministry – Under updated guidelines, Children's Ministry teachers will have to undergo supervised FET (Fast and Easy Testing). Pray for all who need to handle the administration and

preparations needed to resume CD classes in person.

Healthcare Workers – Continue praying for our nation's frontline workers, including many from our church family, as hospital capacities remain stretched.

Our World

North India – Children's camps are being organised by our partner's teams in various regions. Pray for the good organisation of these camps, and for attendees to be blessed with God's love and joy and for their faith to grow. Pray also for the smooth completion of a city church in its final face of construction. Pray for firm faith of our partners and local believers. They face many challenges from putting their faith in Christ.

Myanmar – A 16 year old girl, a church member with our partner, has a damaged valve in her heart. Pray for a suitable hospital and surgeon to be found quickly as she is currently feverish and her oxygen levels are unstable.

Nepal – Brother B will be joining us via Zoom on 29 Oct, Friday for our Missions Prayer Night. Pray for good attendance and a fruitful time of sharing and praying together for the work there. We thank God for Brother B's good work in serving vulnerable children and families. Pray that God will strengthen the faith of believers in our partner's churches. We thank God for opportunities to serve them through online training programmes. May God provide our partner with more workers.

Courage Calls

When the *Courage Calls* conference ended, I immediately took off for a break. It had been an intense 10 weeks of organizing this missions mobilization event. We'd thought we were all set to hold it on-site with all the safe management measures in place. But then news of the Stabilization Phase came just one week before the event itself! We scrambled and pivoted most of the activities online, while onsite gatherings (only one a day) were run in hybrid format - not live-streamed but on ZOOM with 2-way communication.

In the light of the disruptions, we didn't know how many would decide not to come. From the get-go we were already not seeking a large turnout. There was no publicity blitz, and no mention of who the speakers would be. And to 'turn people away even more', the express theme of the Conference would be about Suffering and Persecution for Christ, and about heeding God's call to serve Him in the 'hard places' around the world. I reckon we wanted only as many as the Lord had prepared and within what we could take safely. We had to just trust and obey.

I can't give you the details of all that had happened at the Conference, but let me just mention the final gathering. We heard an elderly woman, who got called to serve in Southeast Asia at the age of 70, share honestly about how she was scared when she received the call, but God gave her courage and she has been pressing on over the last 8 years.

I witnessed dozens of people in the sanctuary, getting down on their knees – the pew they had been seated on became a prayer altar. Those joining in on Zoom likewise got down and prayed upon their chairs. And when the altar call came – a call to full obedience to the Lord wherever He would send you – almost everyone on site responded. Those on Zoom were invited to join a breakout room, where a prayer minister would be available to pray with him or her. I was at the PA console hosting the Zoom meeting and urgently moving people across breakout rooms to ensure that everyone had someone to pray with. I'd never seen an online altar call before, and much rarer have I witnessed such a response.

I needed the break time to reflect on all that had happened. What had just happened? I think it's simply this, that in spite of the pandemic the Lord has been preparing the hearts of His servants of all ages (but especially young adults) to be His witnesses to the ends of the earth. It was our blessing to play a part by hosting *Courage Calls* and to see God at work. It helped make the book of Acts come more alive! Some of our members attended, and I am praying for each of them, that what God had planted in their hearts during those days will bear lasting fruit wherever He leads.

Courage Calls was a missions conference held on 30 Sep - 2 Oct 2021, organized by the Fellowship of Missional Organisations in Singapore and hosted by Zion Bishan.

2021/2022 Mid-Year Financial Review REPORT BY THE SESSION

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We thank God that He has been faithfully providing for the needs of Zion Bishan amidst the unprecedented circumstances we find ourselves in!

For the first 6 months of this financial year, our offering (\$1,641,139) and other income (\$160,153) to the General & Missions Fund (GMF) exceeded our expenses (\$1,293,333) by \$507,959 (see Income & Expenditure table). It was heartening that God's people continued to give so generously during this trying

time. A significant roll-back in our planned expenditure plus contributions from the government's Job Support grant helped to see us through the first half year with a healthy surplus.

Thus far, we have spent 38% of the budget approved at the Feb 2020 ECM. Usually, underspending at mid-year is because most of the expenses tend to occur in the second half of the financial year. Covid19 has continues to put a lot of uncertainty to our plans and has resulted in a lot of planned expenditure being shelved. We continue to seek the Lord's provision and hope to end the financial year without any deficit.

Currently, we have a communicant membership of 1465.

Our Church office currently has 24 pastoral, ministry and admin staff and 5 apprentices, the Living Room has 5 full-time and 2 part-time staff, and ZBK has a total 18 staff. Let us continue to remember these labourers - who anchor the ongoing ministries - in prayer, and serve together with them.

Announcements

Next Step Towards The New Normal Session met on 19 Oct to deliberate, amongst other matters, our worship

services in the light of our observations in September and October. Session is convicted that we need to be good stewards of God's resources and also to urgently address the negative impact of not being able to have regular church worship and activities across all ages and ethnicity. Hence, to enable our children and youths to have regular church-based activities, our worshippers to return more regularly, and to maximize our resources, we will conduct only 250-Persons Vaccinated Only Worship Services for all services. This does not apply to those services which originally do not exceed 50 persons.

We still encourage non-vaccinated worshippers to join us. But as per government regulations, you would need to undergo a Pre-Event Testing (PET) no earlier than 24 hours before you come for service on Sunday. We would like to support you in this PET requirement. The church leaders will reach out to those whom we know to be unvaccinated. We encourage others who are unvaccinated to reach out to us too so that none will be left out.

Most importantly, we may all return inperson to worship God, and in time, have more meaningful fellowship. Above all, let us pray earnestly for God's mercy to restore all things on earth, or if not, may His Son our Lord Jesus return soon.
