Ecclesiastes 9:1-13-10:20

Intro: Qoheleth brings us back to Wisdom (9:13)

Questions for Reflection and Discussion

- 1. Summarise what the Preacher has said about Wisdom in Ecclesiastes so far. What does our passage today add to our understanding of Wisdom?
- 2. What does living the Way of Wisdom in this world mean for you? What are some real life examples of such living?
- 3. How have you either witnessed or personally experienced the frustration of living wisely in this broken world? How does our passage today change the way that you respond to this frustration?
- 4. How does remembering our Poor, Wise Deliverer help motivate us to choose the harder Way of Wisdom? Spend time dwelling on this as He helps us in so many ways!

Prayer Points

Our Church

Christianity Explored (CE) – CE sessions officially begin this week. Pray for the 6 Table Hosts who have stepped up to journey with seekers who are exploring Jesus and the gospel. Pray for the Spirit to be working in the hearts of these seekers as they read through the Gospel of Mark, that they will come to be convicted and receive the good news that Jesus has come to bring.

Living Room (LR) - The Living Room is planning to step up its ministry and outreach work in 2022. Pray for clarity in planning with other ministries and community partners to reach our neighbours in the Bishan community. Pray also for more to volunteer for community outreach, that relationships forged will be effective for sharing the truth and love of Christ.

Today members from Tamil Service assisted by brothers from English Service will be distributing dinner to 40 workers

Migrant Workers Food Distribution -

in a dorm at Penjuru. Please pray that as we invite them for special program for them on Good Friday, they all will attend and the Holy Spirit will speak to their hearts.

Safe-Sound-Sleeping Place (S3P) for Women - Our S3P has sheltered 11 guest stayers since August 2021. This week, our last guest stayers have moved out to a flat. Pray for smooth transition and good follow up, especially for the

ones we are still in touch with. Pray for our volunteers as they look to rest, recharge, and reflect after this season of service.

Our World

India – A partner shared a prayer for more cross cultural workers (trainees) and supporters from the south to the relatively unreached northern states. Pray also for the few Christians in the local communities in the north will be able to continue to raise disciples in their communities who will continue to make disciples wherever they are. Pray for continued wisdom and provision of the necessary resources to continue the community outreach ministries, such as tailoring, life skills training and tuition classes that reaches out to serve the needs of the locals. May the gospel of the kingdom be preached in the whole of India (and the whole world), so that Jesus will return.

Ukraine & Russia – Two mission agencies whom we work with report that their country teams in neighbouring countries to Ukraine have been busy providing basic necessities of food and shelter for the many refugees streaming into their countries. They have also provided a listening ear and counselling for these refugees who have recently experienced so much trauma emotionally and physically. Meanwhile, the two agencies teams in Russia are also facing various challenges and much wisdom is needed to figure out what is the right thing to do.

Ministry & Family

I have had the unique privilege of serving the church as Family Ministry Staff, with the Media and Comms portfolio, for the last two years full time, and as a Family Ministry Apprentice/Intern for two years and nine months before that in a part-time capacity. Reflecting over the last two years, it is almost as if God had purposefully put me in the church staff to serve during this Covid season. My full-time contract began in Mar 2020, alongside Circuit Breaker, and as government measures are beginning to relax, my time as a staff member comes to a close. Although much of the work has been administrative in nature (e.g. bulletin, announcements, website, YouTube, Eventbrite, etc.), I'm sure that God, in His mysterious ways, had prepared me for it.

However, through close to five years of church ministry, it seems that God has been preparing me for something else - Family Ministry... to my own. "I don't think there's a mandate to be found in sacred Scripture that is more solemn than this one. That we are to teach our children the truth of God's Word is a sacred, holy responsibility that God gives to His people. And it's not something that is to be done only one day a week in Sunday school. We can't abdicate the responsibility to the church. The primary responsibility for the education of children according to Scripture is the family, the parents". - R.C. Sproul, Divine Mandate for Parents, ligonier.org

This quote has been a helpful summary of what the Faith at Home and Family Ministry has aimed to do in my time as staff. Throughout my time developing the Faith at Home program and Family Ministry vision, all the books, articles and sermons on ministry to families have greatly impressed upon me God's great desire for the next generation of faith to know who He is and His works through the family. Parents are to "love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might... [and to] teach [His command] diligently to your children" (Deut 6: 5-7).

This isn't anything new to our parents here in Zion Bishan. Almost all who have attended the Faith at Home sessions agree that parents are the primary influencers of the faith of their children. However, it is often in practice that we do not show this to be true. Parents are often challenged by other demands and the family discipleship is hardly high on our priorities. That's where church comes in to constantly remind one another of God's good plan for the faith of the next generation, and to encourage each other in obeying His command as our response to His great love towards us. I hope, by God's grace, He will enable me to continue to do so outside of this official capacity as staff, as we are all called to do as members of the body of Christ.
