Return To Me, And I Will Return To You

5 February 2023

7echariah 1:1-6

Ps Ng Zhiwen / Mr Danny Chua

The Story: Returned from Exile

The Call: "Return to Me" (1:3)

I was very angry with your fathers (1:2)

They did not hear or pay attention to me (1:4)

But my words have outlived your fathers (1:4)

The Promise: "I will return to you" (1:3)

My promised blessings will come true (Deut. 30:1-10)

How must we "return to the Lord" today?

Questions for Reflection & Discussion:

- 1. What do you remember from the sermon and the passage?
- 2. Why is God's promise "I will return to you" (1:3) so encouraging?
- 3. What do we learn about God's words from this passage (1:4-6)
- 4. How must we the church return to the Lord today?

Prayer Points

Our Church

CNY Goody Bag Distribution (29 Jan) – Praise God for the 51 volunteers across all ages from both English and Chinese congregations last Sunday. Many enjoyed the fellowship of the body of Christ. Thank God that many of the residents were receptive and glad to receive the goody bags, some even had meaningful conversations. Pray that the Lord will continue to work in the hearts of residents through the flyers distributed, that they may be open and willing to come for any of our services or ministries.

AG Leaders – Keep in prayer our AG Leaders beginning the year of study in and teaching of the books of Hebrews & Zechariah. Pray that our Father will minister first to the hearts of our AGLs, as they listen to the voice of Jesus. Pray for the AGs journeying through both books, that each member will learn to "run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus." (Heb. 12:1-2).

Zechariah Series – Today we begin our sermon series on Zechariah, a prophetic book that encouraged a downhearted and distracted people facing the urgent, hard work of building God's house, and reminded them of the tremendous implications of God's glory returning to their midst. Pray for:

- Our preachers to be diligent in preparation, being sensitive to both God's Word in the text and God's Spirit in our midst, as they deliver the messages;
- Ourselves to be diligent in our hearing and obedience, whether that Word to us is for challenge or for comfort.

Our World

Philippines - Praise God for our partner, Student Missionary Outreach (SMO) who has been working in the Philippines to bring the gospel to high schools, colleges and universities for the past 45 years. Last Oct, they were able to conduct a mental health symposium for 800 first year college students to educate them on making mental health and well-being a priority. This was a clear need arising from the pandemic. They were able to distribute free books such as "Climbing out of Depression" by Dr. David Meengs from Biblical Counselling Worldwide (BCW) to the students as well. May this word planted in the hearts of the students bear fruit in God's good time.

India - One partner from the Hindi Belt has requested prayer for the urgent need of qualified teachers for their schools in the field. At the same time, this partner hopes to reach out to rural communities through healthcare and medical facilities. May our Lord meet these needs. For another partner, their trainee workers are going out for 2 months of "practical ministry" after completing their Life Skills Training to different parts of East India. Pray for their safety and ministry. May they put their skills to good use and reap a good harvest for the Lord. Despite the many challenges that believers do encounter, give thanks that the fields are growing. May all believers continue to grow in their faith and love for God amidst growing challenges.

What does being Mature in Christ look like in real life?

Yes, you can still send in your answers to my email at alby@zionbishan.org.sg! But why do I ask this question?

I am not asking for theological answers, though any spiritual thoughts are anchored by theological foundations even if we may not state it. I am also not asking for practical answers, like, "How does one mature spiritually?" One can easily give some standard answers such as go to church regularly, read the Bible, pray, give tithes and offerings. Good answers these may be, they can be trite and may even camouflage the true state of our spiritual well-being.

I am asking for personal answers that reflect the realities of yours, and mine, true spiritual state. Of course, you don't have to send your personal "confessions." And just in case you do, be assured that it will be treated with confidence. That is why I asked during the message last Sunday, "What does being Mature in Christ look like in real life, to You?" It is my hope to challenge you, and me, to take stock of our own spiritual journey and maturity.

We do not know where to go if we do not know where we are going. Hence, if we want to be journeying towards spiritual maturity, we must know what spiritual maturity looks like In Our Lives! At your age, in where you are, what you are doing, your personality etc, what would being Mature in Christ look like, in your daily living? It is not some abstract, theoretical or even wistful thoughts like, "How nice if I am able to be like this or that!"

I hope the question will challenge us to intentionally take an inward journey to "see" how we really are and by God's grace, start to shape ourselves into whom we want to be, or more importantly, whom God wants us to be in Christ. It can be done. As Paul assured us:

"For the love of Christ controls us, because we have concluded this: that one has died for all, therefore all have died; and he died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised... Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." (2 Corinthians 5:14-17)
