Ouestions for Discussion and Reflection

- 1. What do you personally find difficult about the Book of Revelation (e.g., how to sort out between various teachings on the end-times; what to do with the bizarre imagery; how to apply the book to my everyday life)?
- 2. How does understanding the book as Apocalypse (revealing ultimate reality); Prophecy (promising rescue and judgment); and Letter (answering everyday-life matters) help?
- 3. Even at this early stage, what would you propose in one or two sentences as the main ideas of Revelation?
 (We can review and revise your answer during and at the end of the sermon series.)

- 1. Do you see Revelation as a relevant and important book that you need to hear? How does today's passage help us to see why we should listen to this book?
- 2. What can we be praying for as we begin our journey into the Book of Revelation?

Prayer Points

Our Church

Missions Month 2023 - Thank God for the messages from various speakers through Missions Month, inspiring us to see God's Mission and His heart in drawing all peoples to Himself. Whether to seek out opportunities to learn about missions, sign up for a short term trip, or pray for a people group, may we respond in action. Pray that we will continue to have spiritual eyes to see the places and people around us who have yet to come under the lordship of Christ. Living Room - Hong Mi, one of our staff from The Living Room will be delivering sometime in August. Please pray for the Lord's favour and protection over mother and child and that the Lord will prepare her bodily, emotionally and mentally for the delivery via c-section.

Our Denomination

Emmanuel BPC – Please pray for Pastor David & Pastor Dev who are beginning a new expository series on the book of Colossians, every Sunday, for the next 3 months. Pray that God's Word will be proclaimed faithfully, and that hearts will be warmed to the gospel.

Our World

India – From the Hindi Belt areas, one partner requests prayer for the provision of places for church buildings as the number of believers have increased. For many 1st generation believers, finding a suitable life partner amongst the limited number of believers in some areas is also a great challenge. Pray that God will provide for suitable partners for believers in this community in North India.

Philippines – Thank God for the safe return of Pastor Theonikko back to the Philippines. He ministers to about 50 to 75 people in a church plant at the Promised Land, the property of the Student Missionary Outreach - Bible Training Institute (SMO-BTI) in Murcia, Philippines. Pray for him as he fulfils his responsibilities as Principal of the BTI and also as he pastors this congregation. They hope to continue reaching out to the isolated villages in these mountain areas and also to other mountain villages where they had given some relief aid.

THANKS FOR YOUR RESPONSE

Revelation

We are starting our sermon series on the Book of Revelation this Sunday! Why study Revelation? Some asked. Here are some reasons:

Firstly, the Christ we read in the Gospels appeared as an earthly human, a baby, a teacher, the Crucified. We only catch a brief glimpse of His glory post-resurrection and at the Ascension. Revelation reveals to us Christ in His full glory and preeminence. More importantly, as John would want us to know he saw Christ and Christ was with him, "When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But he laid his right hand on me, saying, "Fear not..." (Rev 1:17)

John wants us to know beyond a shadow of a doubt, that this glorious Christ is not only there in heaven, but He is also here on earth reassuring John, and us, of His ever-present help in our times of need.

Secondly, the Book of Revelation is like a lens to help us see the world for what it really is. This is especially important for us Singaporean Christians who live, work and worship in relative comfort. It is easy for us to forget that this is a fallen world and one which we want to forsake in the light of the better world to come in Christ's Kingdom.

Having a heavenly view of earth is also helpful for those who are struggling in life. Revelation is a reminder and an encouragement that God has a higher purpose for us. Even if we are to be defeated in this life, we are more than conquerors in Christ and God will execute His judgement on evil and will restore those who are righteous. And while we will have separation from our loved ones on earth, we are promised that we will have a reunion, eternally, in heaven.

Thirdly, the Book of Revelation gives us a glimpse of the glorious future that is awaiting us. It reminds us of Who is awaiting us, God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in the fullest of their splendour. It keeps the weary going. It warns the stragglers to keep on the path. It encourages us all to give our best and live to our fullest for this Heavenly Kingdom.

Let us therefore not be fearful in studying the Book of Revelation but to immerse ourselves in the studying of God's Word with joy. Please feel free to reach out to any preachers should you have any questions or clarifications as we go through the book together.
