Thank God for this opportunity for her and team to serve an unreached people group that God has placed on their hearts. They hope to serve them through a mental wellness programme "Despair to Hope". 2023/2024 Mid-Year Financial Review

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We thank God for His faithfulness in providing our needs at Zion Bishan, month after month, year after year!

For the first 6 months of this financial year 23/24, our **total collection of \$1,982,218**, comprising \$1,890,668 (offering) and \$91,550 (other income), **exceeded our expenditure of \$1,666,292 by \$315,926** (see Income & Expenditure table).

We have budgeted for an expenditure of \$3,900,051 in FY23/24.

The total expenditure was 3.7% higher than the corresponding 6 months in FY22/23. Thus far, we have spent 43% of the budget approved at the Feb 2023 ECM.

Other than the Admin-Ministry (70% spent-to-date with the church camp expenses), we have incurred a higher expenses in Building Maintenance (59% spent to-date).

It has been more than 8 years since we re-developed the church building. We are expected to spend more in Building Maintenance going forward, such as the repair of leaks, replacement of the air-con and other equipment.

Currently, we have a communicant membership of 1,522.

Our Church office currently has 26 pastoral, ministry and admin staff and 1 apprentice. The Living Room has 3 full-time and 5 part-time staff. Let us continue to remember these laborers in prayer, and serve in partnership with them.

We thank the Lord for your continuing giving to the Land Lease Renewal Fund, even as we engage the authorities on the lease renewal. Over the last 6 months, the Lord has enabled us to earn good returns on the fund investing in short term government bonds. The total LLRF in giving, bank interest and investment returns received is **\$9,876,383** as at 31 Aug 2023. We will continue to receive giving towards the LLRF to meet the needs of the eventual lease renewal. Let us continue to pray for God's grace in the lease renewal matter.

Family Mission Trips – A Discipleship Opportunity

Last week, three families from the 430 Congregation – the Foo, Quek and Shi families – brought our eight children to visit the Christian Home of Love in Fang District, three hours north of Chiang Mai.

The goal of this mission trip was different to most: it was to disciple our children (age 2 to 9 years old) by exposing them to what following Jesus looks like in other cultures and contexts. The fathers took turns to lead the group in devotions each morning: memorising Psalm 121 and opening up God's Word. We engaged the children about what they saw and heard: the similarities and differences between what happened as the believers in Northern Thailand gathered compared to what we as a church family do each time we gather here in Singapore.

This wasn't the first Zion Bishan mission trip where parents have brought children along with them. Although there were challenges to organizing such a trip, our desire is that it becomes the norm for families at Zion Bishan to bring even young children on mission trips, to grow their hearts as early as possible for all people groups across the world to know Jesus.

If you are a parent, would you consider using such trips as an opportunity to disciple your children? Speak to myself or any of the families that went if you'd like to find out more – we'd love to tell you more in person about the challenges and joys of the trip. There are also some parents planning to bring their children on trips at the end of this year – Sharon or your congregation pastor will be able to give you more details if you're interested in joining these or any future trips.

For the rest of us, let's encourage and support families to take this opportunity, especially those who might be intimidated at stepping out of our comfort zones this way.

Let us pray that the culture of including our children in our desire to #GetSent grows in Zion Bishan, and that we'll see the next generation grow in their love of Jesus and His Name going to all the earth!
