2024/2025 Mid-Year Financial Review

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We thank God for another year of His faithful and abundance provision to our needs at Zion Bishan!

For the first 6 months of this financial year 24/25, our **total collection is \$2,048,422**, comprising \$1,921,496 (offering) and \$122,883 (other income).

The first 6 months total expenditure at \$1,719,515 was 3.2% higher than the corresponding 6 months in FY23/24. The higher expenditure was more than fully provided by a matching 3.3% increase in collection, resulting in a cash surplus of \$328,907.

While the spending to-date are consistent with past years trending, we praise God for the higher spend in Theological Education with the successful on-boarding of 5 apprentices from the month of July.

Given the aging premises, as anticipated, we have drawn down \$29,561 of the Contingent Provision for unbudgeted building related repairs e.g. roof leakages, and replacements of AV projectors & air-conditioners.

We have thus far spent 80% of the first 6 months budget as approved at the Feb 2024 ECM.

We continue to seek the Lord's provision in all that we need.

Currently, we have a communicant membership of 1,604.

Our Church office currently has 32 pastoral, ministry and admin staff and 6 apprentices. The Living Room has 3 full-time and 3 part-time staff. Let us continue to remember these laborers in prayer, and serve in partnership with them.

We praised God for the successful renewal of our 30-year land lease on 2 Apr 2024 for \$5,259,200, resulting in a balance of \$5,101,851 in the Land Lease Renewal Fund (LLRF).

Further to the resolution approved at the ECM on 25 Feb 2024, we have merged all the remaining monies in the LLRF with the General Projects Fund (GPF). The GPF balance stands at \$5,332,803 as of 31 Aug 2024. The balance has included \$717,745 of investment returns and interest accumulated over the years. We will continue to invest the funds in short term government bonds while awaiting the commencement of the church Additions and Alterations (A&A) Building Project.

Let us continue to pray for God's leading in this A&A Building Project, even as we commence the fresh 30-year land lease to extend His kingdom in Bishan and beyond.

I Am Not

Many of our AGs have been going through John's gospel this year. Despite studying it in detail several times before, I still find that God's Word manages to surprise me.

In John 18, we see Peter's threefold denial of Jesus. Three times he says "I am not" Jesus' disciple. For the longest time, I had assumed that this was because he was afraid. The other disciples were clearly afraid (see Matthew 26:56).

Yet Peter and John followed Jesus as He was taken to see the high priest. In fact, John went into the very area where the trial was being held and seems to invite Peter in also.

More than that, Peter is the only one prepared to fight. He took out his sword and charged at the arresting band (only to get scolded by Jesus). Wasn't that in-line with what he said earlier in John 13? I will lay down my life for you! Here's proof!

No, I don't think Peter was afraid. I think it's much deeper than that.

I think he cannot believe, or understand what Jesus is doing at all. How can this One - declared to be the King of Israel – volunteer to get arrested, put up no fight, speak no protest, go through kangaroo court, be struck by his own people and Roman soldiers too. How can the Messiah, the Son of God, endure mocking, shame, lies and ultimately crucifixion without seeming to exert His power and authority in defence?

I think Peter has a very different understanding of what it means to lay down one's life — and whatever Jesus is doing is rather repulsive to him. It does not fit with his idea of glory. Just like with the foot-washing, Peter wants no part of this Jesus... and so he states, unequivocally, that he is NOT Jesus' disciple. I am not, I am not, I am not.

What does it mean to follow Jesus? What does it mean to lay down one's life for Him? What does it mean to love Him?
