As this is a faith commitment on our part to raise what is needed for them each year, may all who have already been giving specifically to a mission worker continue doing so through the church. For your information, we have 6 cross cultural missions workers (ET, KY, SA, DT, DM and CL) and 3 local ones (RL, JL and JH).
