Luke 11:1-13

Our World

Ministry to the Visually Challenged (VC) in Indonesia - Our partner in this part of Indonesia reports the encouraging testimony of Brother B, who is VC and sells crackers for his living. Our partner has a ministry led by another VC christian brother who helps teach others with similar challenges how to use technology and smart investment to earn a better living. Brother B was served by this ministry and was able to have some money to go to university. Praise God he was able to graduate with a major in Education recently. In addition to helping this community better themselves, this ministry has been able to start an online Bible study with some of them. They now have several people whom they have discipled leading other bible studies in the VC community. May this ministry continue to share the love of Christ to the VC community and their families.

"I believe that before Jesus would have us get sent on mission for Him, He would have us first learn to sit with Him, behold His beauty, listen to His teaching, and catch what is on His heart; And from that place, be ready to give your YES to Jesus."

This is an excerpt from my foreword in this year's camp program booklet. During our pre-camp briefing, and at least twice during the camp itself, I spoke about 3 objectives for everyone at this camp:

Time with Jesus

Time with Family

Time to Say "Yes"

As I looked through the written feedback from our campers, and from what I've gathered from some of you in person, it was heartening to find that this camp served this purpose for many.

There is one thing though that we cannot 'collect feedback' about – it's that unseen part of "Time with Jesus". I really hope that that had been the experience of everyone who came.

Where there were any flaws or faults, that rests on me, and I seek your kind forbearance.

But I am so thankful for everyone who served in one way or another at camp. I am thankful also for those who made a special effort to reach out to our first-time campers, especially those who are not yet part of the Zion Bishan family.

And I'm super grateful for our speaker, and for the committee who worked real hard to make this camp as positive an experience as it could be for our 458 campers.
