Learning from Short Term Trips

Earlier in May, 2 sisters from our church family joined a team comprising members from Bethesda Frankel (BFEC) and students from Singapore Bible College (SBC) on a trip with Radion to Phetchabun, Thailand.

One of Radion's areas of work is in the StreetKIDS Programme (STK), where they work among the Hmong villagers there to identify children who have suffered abuse or come from high-risk backgrounds, extend aid and relief by providing them shelter and education whilst also working alongside their parents or families for a possible future re-entry back to their homes.

Their trip culminated in a children's camp that they organised and conducted together with the local staff team. Here are reflections from our sisters Audrey and Steffi' on their time there.

Audrey Tang:

I first learned about Radion and their work among the Hmong people in Thailand in 2023. The opportunity came when the missions calendar was shared in January this year, I realized I was available for the dates in May. Though I was initially hesitant—being one of only two from Zion Bishan—I felt God's clear prompting. Once I said "yes," a sense of peace and anticipation followed. I was excited to embark on this journey with new friends from SBC and BFEC.

As an organisation, Radion calls these trips "Mission Learning Journey," and this was exactly that. Rather than simply going to serve, I was there to learn—about God, my walk with Him, and His heart for people. The three-day retreat before ministry began gave me rare, unhurried time to reflect, rest in nature, and reconnect with God.



One message God placed on my heart was that every child is precious in His sight. I remembered my own childhood encounter with Jesus and shared my testimony with the Radion children and those at camp. We also visited a local Hmong church and an elderly couple who once served as shamans for their clan in their community.

Learning the Thai language was challenging, but the Radion team guided us patiently—even sending us to buy dinner at the market! Then came the 3-day Early Intervention Camp where local children stayed over, played games, went on excursions, and we spent time getting to know each other. Being with Sii Som (Orange team in Thai) reminded me to love each child like Jesus would. Because we are all called to share His love, my part is simply to respond and obey. I return home with a prayerful heart, fond memories and a renewed desire to proclaim Him to the next generation.

### **Steffi Gan:**

A highlight of this learning trip for me was the unhurried time with the Lord before the children’s camp — listening and talking to Him and simply enjoying His presence. Surrounded by nature, the hymn *“This Is My Father’s World”* came alive. The mountains lifted my eyes to the Maker of heaven and earth. The wildflowers reminded me to consider Christ and His ways. The beauty of creation pointing to its Creator reminded me that I, too, am His handiwork — *made for His glory.*



Before and during this trip, I wrestled with the question: *“Why am I here?”* The children had dreams of becoming teachers, policemen, and shop owners. But what if these dreams don’t come true? What if hopes fail? Are we then giving false hope?

Then it struck me: there is a greater hope that transcends all others — *“In Christ alone, my hope is found.”* This is why I am here — not to *“save”*, but to point to the true Saviour, Jesus, our eternal hope.



*To live is Christ* — He is my purpose.

I realised I had fallen into a saviour complex, forgetting that my only rightful place is to point to Him. The true tragedy is not unfulfilled dreams — it's dying without Christ.

During the children's camp, I shared how I know God is real in my life and why Jesus had to die on the cross.

I'm thankful for the time at Radion and church camp that reminded me to prioritise intimacy with the Lord — seeking Him in His Word and praying earnestly for His desires, both personally and as a church. I want to *"need Thee every hour"* — not occasionally, but constantly, because for my heart to beat for what truly matters to Him, it must first be attuned to His.

*"Tune my heart to sing thy grace"*
