Weep for Israel (9:1-5)

I could wish that I were accursed...

There is Israel, and there is Israel (9:6-13)

It is not as though God's word has failed.

Who decides who is Israel? (9:14 – 18)

God, who has mercy.

God – Potter | Israel – Jars of Clay (9:19 – 23)

God's Word Never Fails

Romans 9:1-29

Intro: Good news & wonderful promises (Romans 8)

Question: But... What if... God breaks promises?

No - God's word has not failed (9:6)

1. God's blessings are still *open to the Jews* – unbelieving Israel (9:1-5)
2. God has always chosen to save some, *but not by works* (9:6-13)
3. God has always chosen to save some, *only out of His mercy* (9:14-18)
4. God has always said *He would save many (Gentiles) from the nations* (9:19-29)

Reflecting: How is my heart responding to God today?

Discussion Questions:

1. What are some things that stood out to you from the Bible passage or message?
2. Why does it matter to the children of God today that God keeps His promises, even those made to the Jews in the Old Testament scriptures (9:5-6)?
3. "God has always chosen to save some sinners, not by works, but by His mercy." (9:6-18) How do you find yourself responding to this picture of God?
4. Do you agree that God is just – in that *He shows mercy on some sinners* when all humanity really deserve His wrath for knowingly rejecting Him (1:18-32)? Why or why not?
