# **Logical Worship**

Romans 12:1-2

Intro: Spiritual (Greek: Logical) Worship (12:1b)

[1] I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual (logical) worship.

[2] Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect

The Appeal: Sacrificial Worship (12:1b)

Worship: Presenting holy and acceptable sacrifices (Leviticus 1-7)

# **Gospel-Shaped Sacrificial Worship:**

i. A response to God's Mercies (12:1a)

God's Mercies in Romans 1-11

<b>ii.</b> A Spir	itual & Logical Response (12:1b & 2a)
	The Spirit's work in transforming our minds (8:5, 8:13-14 etc)
	Transformed, not conformed (1:21, 28's futile and debased minds)
Conclusion: Ou	ur Logical Response: Worship!

- 1. What do you think of Paul's appeal? What is your response to being a living sacrifice? What are your reasons behind saying yes or no to this appeal?
- 2. What difference does the Gospel from Romans 1-11 make to your response? Do you think being a living sacrifice is a logical response?
- 3. How would you describe the Spirit's role in all of this? How exactly does He help transform your mind?
- 4. In what specific ways have you been challenged to be a Living Sacrifice personally today? What does this look like in our life together as a wider Zion Bishan family?

We didn't have much of a plan or a methodology, other than to prioritise the preaching of God's Word and do our best to genuinely love the saints. Most weeks things didn't look too rosy. Many lamented over the seemingly insurmountable challenges and issues.

Yet little by little, God surprised us. As we kept faithfully teaching and serving, some visitors came and even stayed. A few returned to the Lord after a season of absence, and a couple of AGs were formed. We even elected a new shepherd!

In recent times, a new generation has come in. Youth from unexpected places gathered and requested baptism! It felt like life was returning in a small but substantial way.

For us who were in the thick of things, it felt like mini miracle after mini miracle (the real benefit of church leadership!). Just trust and keep plodding on — God will provide, God will lead, God will guide...

More and more I am convinced that we should never trust in the flesh – not in our resources, wealth, intellect, expertise, techniques or even ministry experience. We must trust in the Lord, we must walk by faith, we must lead by faith – God will do everything!
