Romans 13:1-7

"Be subject to the governing authorities ..."

Why submit? (vv. 1b-5)

Authorities are appointed by God ... (vv 1b-4)

For the purpose of punishing the wrongdoer... (vv. 3-5)

How to submit? (vv. 6-7)

Questions for Reflection & Discussion:

- According to Paul in Rom 13:1-7, what is the role of governing authorities?
 What happens in a society when there are no acknowledged authorities, or they don't function properly? What examples can you give?
- 2. Paul describes the "governing authorities" as "God's servant" twice in these verses. In what senses can government be a servant of God?
- 3. Read Acts 16:35–40 and 23:1–3. How can Romans 13:1–7 regarding government be reconciled with Paul boldly telling authorities they are acting illegally or unjustly?
- 4. What does it mean for Christians today that, on the one hand, God has appointed rulers who are meant to govern under the rule of appropriate law and, on the other, that Jesus is already installed as the supreme Lord of heaven and earth?

Earthly Submission unto God

Romans 13:1-7

Brothers and sisters, let us submit to earthly authorities since...

1. God is the Ultimate Ruler who put them in place (13:1-2)

Even evil rulers: (1 Kgs. 12:15; Jer. 27:6; John 19:10)

2. God appointed them for our good, to carry out His wrath on wrong (13:3-7)

Social order serves God's purposes to save many through Jesus (1 Tim. 2:1-7)

But what about bad earthly authorities? 3 reminders for God's people who...

- 1. Live under earthly affliction (8:31-35)
- 2. Await God's judgment for His people who overcome evil with good (12:14-21)
- 3. Follow God's Son His earthly submission shapes ours (1:1-4)

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What was one thing that stood out to you from the Bible passage or message?
- 2. Do you see earthly authorities as "instituted by God" (13:1)? Why or why not?
- 3. What makes it hard for you to submit to earthly authorities give an example. Why?

God in the Mess!

Do you notice that life tends towards mess? What was a nicely ironed shirt in the morning is often a crumpled mess by the end of the day.

Where is God when life get's messy?


Sometimes it's hard to see Him and understand that He is there with you in the mess.

This was the teaching challenge that our church group of 2 faced recently, when they were in Nepal, serving the senior boys and girls in one of our partner's centres. The theme of their youth camp was "Love in the mess". On day 1 of the youth camp, they shared about how **sin** causes disorder and mess in our lives and the world we live in.

And it was so true, this South Asian country had seen violence and conflict in its capital city just days before the team had to fly. Yet through the mess, God enabled peace to come back and flights to resume and the weather to be good enough to fly so that the team could travel to this small town to share God's love to the youth in this centre. God's love through the mess of the recent political conflict was evident!

On day 2, through songs, object lessons (see picture below) and times of discovery in the Word of God, they were able to bring across the main point of seeing "God's Love in the mess".





How about for you personally? Life, at work, at school and even in church, is often messy, unpredictable, DIFFICULT. And SIN in this world is a big reason why this is so. However, through acknowledging our sin in sorrow and firmly trusting in Jesus, God shows us His LOVE in our mess. Jesus came to us to love us and take the penalty of our sins. In doing so, He made the way back to our heavenly Father.

Last week, a group of 3 brothers, left for Nepal to encourage a fellow brother and his family to keep reaching out to his own people who have yet to know Jesus. "...How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news"- Romans 10:15b

Church, may we all have the boldness to live LIFE, trusting fully in the goodness of our loving Saviour and heavenly Father to guide and journey with us all the way to the end.
